Scholarships and Bursaries

The University of Waterloo and the Faculty of Mathematics together offer entrance scholarships to students who accept their offer of admission and meet our requirements. The Faculty of Mathematics offers as many as 200 scholarships ranging from \$1,000 to full cost. In addition, the University of Waterloo offers entrance scholarships based on grades and bursaries based on financial need.

Information for Students Who Plan to Apply for Admission in Fall 2020

Faculty of Mathematics Promissory Scholarship

Students who write the Euclid Mathematics Contest in their grade 11 year will automatically be considered for a Faculty of Mathematics Promissory Scholarship. If successful, students will receive this scholarship the following year provided they apply and are successfully admitted to any program (excluding Software Engineering and Computing and Financial Management) in the Faculty of Mathematics.

Information for Students Applying for Fall 2019 Admission

1. Mark the application deadlines on your calendar

- February 4, 2019 – Faculty of Mathematics Olympiad, National and Global Scholarship application deadline. Please visit uwaterloo.ca/math/future-undergraduates/funding-and-awards/faculty-mathematics-entrance-scholarships for application information.
- Mid April 2019 – University of Waterloo Entrance Bursary application deadline.

2. Prepare for and write the Euclid Mathematics Contest or the Canadian Senior Mathematics Contest

- Talk to your Math teacher about participating in Canadian Senior Mathematics Contest and/or the Euclid Contest.
- The Canadian Senior Mathematics Contest will be written on Wednesday, November 21, 2018.
The Euclid Mathematics Contest will be written on Wednesday, April 3, 2019.
- You must write the Canadian Senior Mathematics Contest and/or the Euclid Mathematics Contest during the school year immediately prior to when you will begin studies at Waterloo to be eligible for Faculty of Mathematics entrance scholarships.

3. Tell us about yourself through the Admission Information Form (AIF)

- Get your AIF at uwaterloo.ca/future-students/admissions/admission-information-form
- Complete the AIF carefully and return it to the University of Waterloo according to the instructions on it.
- Each AIF is read and scored and is used to help make admission and scholarship decisions.

Information for Admitted Students

When Will You Hear From Us?

The Faculty of Mathematics Entrance Scholarships, which are based on your admission average, Admission Information Form (AIF) score, and Euclid Contest or Canadian Senior Mathematics Contest result, are awarded in mid-May. You may receive notice of a Faculty of Mathematics scholarship after you receive your offer of admission.

The President's Scholarships, which are based on grades alone, are awarded when you receive your offer of admission or possibly later when all your grades are received by the University.

Eligible students are invited to apply for these scholarships. Deadline for submission is February 4, 2019.

2019 Faculty of Mathematics Entrance Scholarships

There are approximately 200 entrance scholarships for students ranging from \$1,000 to \$10,000. These scholarships are granted **automatically** based on your secondary school performance, Euclid Mathematics Contest or the Canadian Senior Mathematics Contest results, and Admission Information Form.

There may be other scholarships available through your school or community. Check with your guidance counselor for information on scholarship availability and application procedures.

2019 Faculty of Mathematics Promissory Scholarships

2019 Promissory Scholarship offers were made in June 2018 to grade 11 students who performed extremely well on the 2017 Euclid Mathematics Contest. Students who were offered a Promissory Scholarship also received information on how to redeem the scholarship.

Financial Need Bursaries

Bursaries can be a helpful supplement to students' primary sources of funding, such as employment income, parental contributions, and OSAP.
